- Harvard Business School MBA alumni within the last 7-10 years.
- Post-doctoral candidates within the first 5 years of their training program in a Harvard program or research lab.

Guidelines to consider when applying

- Receive \$100K stipend over 12 months.
- Have access to \$35K operating funds to support enterprise creation.
- Commit to attend regular Fellowship meetings and events from June 2019- May 2020.
- Use work space provided in Harvard's i-lab.
- Reside in the Boston area.

Application timelines

You may apply to the Blavatnik Fellowship under <u>either</u> our <u>Fall Decision Round</u> or <u>Spring Decision Round</u>. Application dates for the 2019-2020 class (starting on or about June 1, 2019) are below. You may apply in one round only, one time in an application year. Applications received after the deadline will not automatically be considered for the next round, unless applicant directly notifies the Fellowship.
